



On Saturday, September 28th at 8:30 a.m. we'd like to assemble a group of volunteers for an outdoor project at Alumni House (832 N. 25th Street). The result of this project will be the elimination of seepage into the basement and improve the ambient light into the basement. Earlier this year glass block was installed in the wall openings replacing the old windows or wood paneling closing off the openings.

All tools and gloves will be provided so what we need is your limbered up bodies to dig out the wells, locate the gravel and steel/ aluminum retainers. Beverages and lunch will be provided. We'd like to start at 8:30 a.m. and hopefully will conclude by mid afternoon.
