Who: Women of all ages who want to be inspired!!!

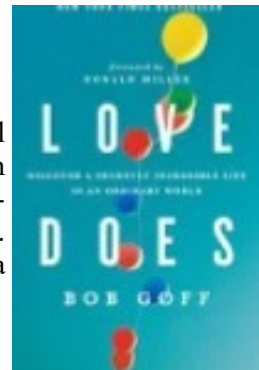
When: We meet every other Monday. Our next meeting will be on October 14th

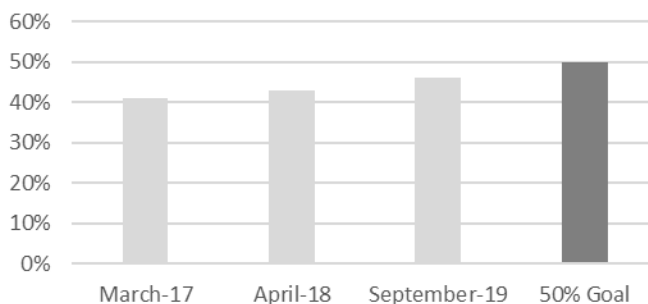
